Morocco	oranges, melons, and watermelons
Spain	grapes and oranges, mandarins/clementines
Syria	oranges, melons, apples
Tunisia	watermelons, oranges, grapes and dates
Turkey	watermelons, grapes, apples
Occupied Palestinian Territories	grapes and oranges.
