Preparation of a portfolio of pilot project proposals (2013-2014)

- ❖ **Based on priorities identified**

- ✓ under the Barcelona convention and its protocols
 - ✓ existing/on-going national strategies/policies related to SCP or Green Economy, identified during the Scoping Missions or specified by Government representatives

- ❖ **Building on**

- ✓ Past Successful projects in the SWITCH-Med Countries
 - ✓ SCP/RAC past projects and gained expertise
 - ✓ UNEP past projects and gained expertise

Pilot Project Portfolio

➤ *Presented to the beneficiary countries in June 2014*

TOURISM



- Sustainable Public Procurement (SPP) and the link to the Touristic Sector: the creation of a supplier network oriented to the adoption of ICZM strategies
- Enhancing the SPAMI label through sustainable tourism activities
- Changing tourism practices: eco-tourism excursion
- Recycling of organic waste in tourist and market facilities

AGRO-FOOD & AGRICULTURE



- Resources efficiency in the olive oil sector
- Foot-printing in the food industry
- Awareness raising campaign on environmentally sound agriculture practices
- Water Stewardship in the food sector

HOUSING, CONSTRUCTION AND MOBILITY



- Sustainable buildings in coastal areas
- Sustainable Location and Construction
- Improvement of mobility and transport networks in rural coastal zones
- Design and management of 30KM/H districts

GOODS MANUFACTURING



- Implementation of Life Cycle Management in a key industrial sector
- Eco-design of packaging, as a preventive approach to address Marine Litter
- Medical waste management

Repartition of countries

➤ *Presented to the beneficiary countries in October 2014*

- **Group A:**

- The pilot projects addressing existing SCP national priorities falling under the framework of the Barcelona Convention and its Protocols will be identified and developed during the period 2014-2016.
- Coordinated by **SCP/RAC**
- 4 members of the Barcelona Convention, namely **Algeria, Morocco, Tunisia and Lebanon** .

- **Group B:**

- The pilot projects addressing priorities identified by the SCP National Action Plans that are currently being prepared by UNEP/DTIE together with the concerned countries will be developed at a later stage.
- Coordinated by **UNEP/DTIE**
- 5 countries: **Egypt, Libya, Jordan, Palestine and Israel**.

Consultation phase (on-going)

- **For the countries under the responsibility of SCP/RAC (launched in October 2014)**
 - ❖ **Consultation process**
 - ✓ Based on the portfolio of project ideas
 - ✓ Through an online questionnaire (to choose a project from the portfolio or suggest a new project)
 - ✓ Asking for coordination with MAP and SCP/RAC NFP
 - ❖ **Results**
 - ✓ Algeria: consultation on-going – interest in Agro industry activities (oil waste) – SCP National Assessment (UNEP DTIE) expected to be finalized by the end of July – action plan in September.
 - ✓ Morocco prefers to wait for the selection of the sectors to be tackled by the SCP National Assessment.
 - ✓ Tunisia and Lebanon submitted their proposals (project from the portfolio)

Selected projects

❖ **Tunisia**

- ✓ Recycling of organic waste in tourist and market facilities
- ✓ Djerba Island in Tunisia
- ✓ Areas of the Project: Food/Tourism/Municipal waste management

❖ **Lebanon**

- ✓ Implementation of the Life Cycle Management (LCM) approach and the Eco-design perspective to key products to help address resource efficiency challenges throughout the life of products.
- ✓ Sector of action: wineries
