










Beyond Plastic Med BeMed



ACTIVITIES: Recommendations and New Regulations

OS2: Draft, approval and promotion of local laws to prevent plastics

A2.1: Rise of a regional and international team of experts to draft the laws: created a regional staff and organized several seminars

A2.2: Prepared an discuss in workshops with island municipalities the draft law according to European Union: Organization of workshops in 6 municipalities covering the 10 islands to discuss the draft law.

A2.3: Approval of a new law preventing plastic use in municipality's councils: For the first time ever, 6 municipalities of 10 islands will be accorded a plastic protection law

A2.4: Promotion and sensitizing of the law stopping plastic use from young people: Informing tourists and local community regarding preventing laws of plastics in islands. Meetings with fishermen associations and travel agencies associations for consulting and approval of the law, have been another aspect for implementing this project.




We are Common Seas: A global team on a mission to reduce the amount of plastic made and stop it polluting our rivers and seas. Our project, Clean Blue Alliance, is building a global network of plastic waste-free islands.



How it works

Clean Blue Alliance delivers systems change through three phases:





Investigate: Identify waste streams and leakage

Building a complete picture of an island's plastic ecosystem, we identify the best levers for change and create the foundations to measure impact.



ISLAND WASTE AUDIT:

Discovered 16% of waste entering the landfill could be recycled.

MARINE LITTER AUDIT:

Audited 30,000 sq.m of coastline and found plastic cups, bottles and cigarette butts are key problematic plastics.


SOCIAL AUDIT:

Interviewed 1000 people and learnt that islanders and tourists want businesses to help them to reduce their plastic use.



Intervene: Incubate and accelerate solutions

We used our understanding of plastic on Paros to design the right solutions to tackle the problem.



SUPPORTING BUSINESSES:

We've worked with over 100 businesses to help them reduce their plastic waste.

DRINKING TAP WATER:

Having proven Paros water is safe, we are running a campaign to help residents and tourists switch to tap.

ENHANCING EDUCATION:

Educational materials on plastic and the sea are equipping the next generation to keep their island clean and blue.



Influence: Replicate and scale best practices

A successful solution is one that can scale. By testing & demonstrating the impact of our interventions, we help them attract support, inform government policy and rapidly scale.





BUSINESS:

Online platform supporting hospitality businesses to break free from plastic waste.

EDUCATION:

Embedding lasting change by scaling our education program nationally through the Ministry of Education.

GOVERNMENT:

Demonstrations of circular economy are guiding implementation of the EU Single-Use Plastic Directive.
