SCP Roadmap for the Mediterranean

SCP embedded in Barcelona Convention, MSSD + MAP PoW

- Aim of SWITCH MED is to design and support implementation of specific SCP measures to achieve defined goals of these policy frameworks
- Ecosystem Approach (ECAP) is required, addressing major impacts on Mediterranean marine and coastal ecosystems, aiming to conserve integrity
- **Targets and indicators** are required to:
 - define, monitor and manage these ecosystems;
 - to measure progress towards establishment of SCP patterns and enhance resource efficiency; **and**
 - measure economic, social and environmental gains from shift to SCP.
- Measuring gains is crucial for replication, scaling up and mainstreaming SCP in other policies (industry, finance, development + planning ministries)
- Collect indicator baselines NOW, so we can measure our success

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SCP Targets and Indicators (cont.)

- Need targets and indicators for the duration of the project (2015 mid term + 2017 end), as well as to 2020
- Can we really establish targets for 2030 and 2050?
- Can develop these targets with close reference to H2020 targets:
 - EU donor will appreciate this linkage, understanding need for adaptation to non-EU member states conditions and priorities
- SCP roadmap vision (p 13):
 - “new models of SCP, for new paradigm of socio-economic development, achieving decoupling and contributing to ecosystem protection”
- Ensure linkage with indicators developed for 10YFP and the SDGs – report of HLP on post 2015 agenda identifies SCP as a central theme/objective
