Consultant Prevention of New PoPs

Prevention of New POPs

- Assist UNEP MAP SCPRAC on the overall technical development of the project document related to the prevention of New POPs (in particular, DecaBDE, SCCP, HBCD and PFOs);
- Support the Ministry of Environment and other key stakeholders to research New POPs background information;
- Support the identification of New POPs users (as a minimum, list of companies and contact person (address, phone and email) soliciting Stockholm Convention exemptions) in the country;
- Contact New POPs users for project collaboration and possible site visit (as a minimum, contact the provided list of companies/sectors soliciting Stockholm Convention exemptions) in the country;
- Support conducting research and inventory of New POPs use (New POP type, quantity used per year and exact location/company) in the country.

Tasks

Under the direct supervision of the UN Environment/MAP SCPRAC in consultation with the GEF project manager responsible for the overall preparation of the MedProgramme, the consultant will be responsible for the following overall tasks:

1. Support the preparation of a detailed work plan in consultation, when appropriate, with the consultant recruited by the implementing agency UNEP MAP and SCPRAC;
2. Contribute to the completion of New POPs inventory including New POPs use, location of stockpiles as well as disposal plans and their estimated cost;
3. Finalize the New POPs inventory with the data provided by participating countries and local consultants;
4. Make economic scenarios on the concrete activities describing the cost of prevention and substitution of New POPs with support from local consultants;
5. Prepare plans for substitution of New POPs use per country with support from local consultants;
6. Prepare plans for disposal of New POPs stockpiles (being use) per country if needed;
7. Prepare and provide inputs for UN Environment/MAP bodies reporting and for communication purposes and prepare progress reports on timely manner.

Expected outputs

1. Support the preparation of a Detailed Work Plan per country on prevention of New POPs (Task 1);
2. Guidance and format for preparing inventory of New POPs with the consultant recruited by the implementing agency UNEP MAP and SCPRAC and local consultants in each participating (Task 2);
3. Support the inventory of about 400 tons of New POPs use (Task 3);
4. Support the preparation of concrete activities for the prevention of New POPs and the estimated cost of implementing alternatives (Task 4);
5. Support the preparation of concrete activities for disposal of New POPs being used by companies and their cost estimated per country (Task 5);
6. Support the development of a report on the baseline scenario (current status) and alternative scenario (list of specific activities under the MedProgramme) on the prevention of New POPs per country (Task 6).
